

TRIVIEW METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

RESOLUTION 03-2016

WHEREAS, Triview Metropolitan District (the "District"), in the County of El Paso and State of Colorado, is a quasi-municipal corporation and political subdivision duly organized and existing under the Constitution and the laws of the State of Colorado, particularly the Special District Act, Title 32, Article 1, Colorado Revised Statutes (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the members of the Board of Directors of the District (the "Board") have been duly elected, chosen and qualified; and

WHEREAS, within the five months immediately preceding the special election herein called, the District has not held any election on the proposition of creating any indebtedness of the District which was defeated, in accordance with Section 32-1-106(2) of the Act; and

WHEREAS, Article X, Section 20 of the Colorado Constitution ("TABOR") requires voter approval for any new tax, tax rate increases, mill levy above that for the prior year, and the creation of any debt and for spending certain moneys above limits established by TABOR; and

WHEREAS, TABOR requires the District to submit ballot issues (as defined in TABOR) to the District's electors on limited election days; and

WHEREAS, November 8, 2016, the regular presidential election date, is one of the election dates at which ballot issues may be submitted to the eligible electors of the District pursuant to TABOR; and

WHEREAS, the interest of the District and the public interest and necessity demand and require the District to seek voter approval to collect, retain and spend revenues it receives in the fiscal year 2018 and thereafter for District purposes; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit to the electors of the District, at the Election, the propositions of collecting, retaining and spending revenues it receives in the fiscal year 2018 through 2028 for the specific purposes enumerated below in the Ballot Question; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to set forth certain procedures concerning the conduct of the Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF TRIVIEW METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, EL PASO COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. All action heretofore taken (not inconsistent with the provisions of this resolution) by the District and the officers thereof, directed toward the Election and the objects and purposes herein stated is, ratified, approved and confirmed. Unless otherwise defined herein, all terms used herein shall have the meanings specified in the Code.

Section 2. Pursuant to the applicable laws of the State of Colorado, the Board notes that an election shall be held on November 8, 2016, at which there shall be submitted to the eligible electors of the District the questions set forth in Section 4 hereof.

Section 3. The Board hereby designates Valerie Remington to act as the Designated Election Official with regard to the TABOR election, and she is hereby authorized and directed to proceed with any action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution and of the Act, the Code, TABOR, or other applicable laws.

Section 4. The Board hereby authorizes and directs the officers of the District to certify on or before August 1, 2016, the following question in substantially the form hereinafter set forth. Such question shall be submitted to the eligible electors of the District at the election.

COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2018 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2028, SHALL TRIVIEW METROPOLITAN DISTRICT, WITHOUT INCREASING EXISTING TAX RATES OR IMPOSING A NEW TAX, BE AUTHORIZED, FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAYING DOWN THE DISTRICT'S DEBT SOONER, TO COLLECT, RETAIN AND SPEND AS A VOTER APPROVED REVENUE CHANGE PURSUANT TO ARTICLE X, SECTION 20 OF THE COLORADO CONSTITUTION AND REGARDLESS OF THE PROVISIONS OF ANY OTHER LAW, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION THE 5.5% PROPERTY TAX REVENUE LIMIT OF 29-1-301 C.R.S.,

C1) ALL REVENUES ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE DISTRICT'S GENERAL FUND SUCH AS PROPERTY TAXES, SPECIFIC OWNERSHIP TAXES, SALES TAXES, PROPERTY TAXES AND OTHER REVENUES RECEIVED FROM THE TOWN OF MONUMENT, COLORADO, IMPACT FEES, GRANT REVENUES, AND INVESTMENT INCOME, AND

C2) IN ANY YEAR IN WHICH THE DISTRICT'S WATER AND SEWER UTILITY DOES NOT QUALIFY AS AN ENTERPRISE, ~~REVENUES~~ *Revenues* ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE

ENTERPRISE FUND, SUCH AS WATER AND SEWER USER FEES, TAP FEES,
INCLUSION FEES, WATER REUSE FEES, GRANTS, AND INVESTMENT INCOME?


Section 5. The officers of the District be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to take all action necessary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of this resolution.

Section 6. Pursuant to Section 1-11-203.5, C.R.S., any election contest arising out of a ballot issue or ballot question election concerning the order of the ballot or the form or content of the ballot title shall be commenced by petition filed with the proper court within five days after the title of the ballot issue or ballot question is set.

Section 7. All orders, bylaws and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this resolution, are hereby repealed.

Section 8. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this resolution.
