## TRIVIEW METROPOLITAN DISTRICT RESOLUTION NO. 06-2016

## A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A POLICY REGARDING PUBLIC COMMENT AT BOARD MEETINGS

WHEREAS, the Triview Board of Directors has determined it necessary to establish rules relative to public comment at board meetings in order to facilitate the orderly conduct of business; and

WHEREAS, the Board has authority to establish such rules pursuant to Colorado Revised Statutes 32-1-1001(1)(m) which provides that the Board has to power "To adopt, amend, and enforce bylaws and rules and regulations not in conflict with the constitution and laws of this state for carrying on the business, objects and affairs of the board and of the special district;" and

WHEREAS, the Board believes public comment is desirable but also believes it should be limited in duration and should only address items not on the board's meeting agenda; and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that public comment should be limited to three minutes per person at Board meetings and comment under the public comment section of the agenda should be limited to items not on the agenda for consideration by the board.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF THE TRIVIEW METROPOLITAN DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1. Public Comment. The Board of Triview Metropolitan District hereby determines that public comment on items not on the agenda at board meetings will be limited to three minutes per person in order to facilitate the orderly and timely conduct of board business.

Section 2. Notice. Notice of the three-minute time limit shall be printed on the bottom of board agendas as follows: "Notice is hereby given that individual comment under the public comment section of the agenda is limited to three minutes and shall only be on items not on the agenda pursuant to Resolution 06-2016."
