

OPPORTUNITY – NORTHERN DELIVERY SYSTEM

- ✓ Triview has purchased/leased nearly 4,000 acre feet of storage in Big Johnson Reservoir, Stonewall Springs South Reservoir and a 40 year excess capacity storage contract in Pueblo Reservoir
- ✓ Triview has purchased nearly 2,000-acre feet of water located on Fountain Creek, the Upper Arkansas River Basin, and the Lower Arkansas River Basin
- ✓ The proposed Northern Delivery System would construct a booster pump station, 10mile pipeline and a tank to move potable water as a part of NDS delivery



PROJECT BENEFITS – NORTHERN DELIVERY SYSTEM

- ✓ Bring renewable water to northern areas of El Paso County which will reduce reliance on non-renewable groundwater that is decreasing in quantity and quality
- ✓ Improves water quality by providing clean, renewable treated water
- ✓ Improves fire protection for areas along pipeline route including Fox Run Regional Park










Proposed 1 MG Storage Tank

What will it look like?




